## What is a meme?

a meme refers to <u>a unit of culture or communication</u> that spreads through imitation, often with a humorous or catchy element

unlike typical forms of communication they <u>transcend</u>
<u>language barriers</u> allowing the meme to spread outside
of its inital culture








### Image Macros










### Reaction memes

- often expresses a particular emotion or feeling that the poster is feeling so great for lexis related to emotions


